Jeffrey L. Page returns to Geva with Lady Day at Emerson's Bar & Grill

Rochester, N.Y. — Geva Theatre is delighted to announce the return of Jeffrey L. Page, who brought his re-envisioning of *Ain't Misbehavin'* to the Wilson Stage during the 50th Season, to direct the biographical Billie Holiday musical *Lady Day at Emerson's Bar & Grill* this winter. *Lady Day at Emerson's Bar & Grill* will replace *I Put a Spell on You*, the fifth show during the 23/24 season. Geva Theatre will welcome *I Put a Spell on You* in the 24/25 season instead.

"We are so thrilled to have Jeffrey L Page returning next season with his beautiful new production of *Lady Day at Emerson's Bar & Grill*," says Artistic Director Elizabeth Williamson. "As he did with *Ain't Misbehavin'*, he has gone back to the roots of this story, with a fresh new vision of what Billie Holiday was grappling with at the end of her life."

Page says, "*Lady Day at Emerson's Bar & Grill* is a final accounting of Billie Holiday's life, flashing before her eyes. As we watch her — in real-time — uncover battles with various facets of abuse, racism, sexism, self-torment, love, and loss, we also witness her gain a cathartic release." The Tony Award-winning musical depicts the final performance Billie Holiday gave of her career before her untimely passing four months later. With a live jazz band, intimate setting, you feel as though you're in Emerson's Bar and Grill in 1959.
